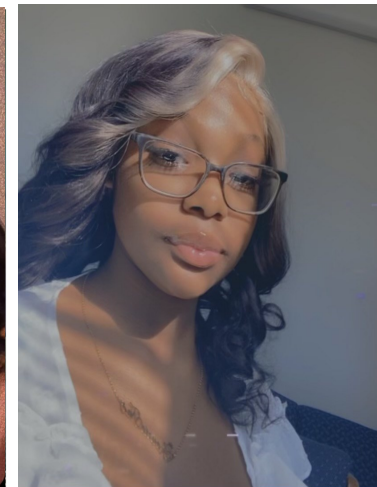
**At an early age, she joined the Ebenezer Baptist Church. She was employed at Samson Manufacturing for 23 years.**
